Visitor Guidelines

Food and Drink

Food is not allowed in the Museum. Covered drinks (water bottles, soda bottles, etc.) are welcome. There is a water fountain in the lobby.

Photography/Video

Bring your camera! Non-professional photography is welcome in the Museum; if you are a professional photographer wanting to do a photo shoot, news story, etc., please contact us in advance. Tripods and flash photography are prohibited inside.

Touching

There are several interactive elements within the Berkeley County Museum. These elements are clearly labeled. Otherwise, please do not touch. If you're unsure, ask a staff member or volunteer. Also, please do not touch or place drinks on top of artifacts or display cases.

Pets

Though we love animals, pets are not allowed within in the Museum. Service animals are permitted.

Smoking

Smoking and vaping are not permitted within the Museum building. Guests may smoke outside. Please be mindful of your surroundings.

Unaccompanied Children

Children enjoy history too! We welcome children and their guardians to explore the museum. Young children (11 years old and younger) are required to have an adult with them for their entire visit. This is sometimes adjusted for education groups; please contact us in advance.
